#### **Nursery Activities**

## **Baby Room**

This month the babies have been having fun exploring in water in a variety of ways, exploring the paddling pool, filling and emptying containers and even building with ice cubes!

The babies have focused on different types of books, textured and mechanical. This involved the children using their fine motor skills to operate them, improving their balance and coordination. Reading them as a group allowed the children to engage with each other and enhance their cognitive development.

The babies have been exploring the small world animals, learning about the different animal sounds, movements and habitats. The children have taken part in printing activities with them and even hiding them for their friends to find.

#### **Pre-School Room**

This month the children in the Pre-School room have been very busy learning about different life cycles. We have been watching caterpillars change into chrysalis before emerging as butterflies, which were then released in the garden to much excitement. We have also seen tadpoles turn into froglets and then finally frogs.

We have introduced individual workbooks for all children, which they have also been using to further enhance their mark making and writing skills helping to encourage their hand and eye co-ordination. The children use their books within their free play and circle times, this helps the children develop in their interaction and social skills, showing their peers what they have drawn and giving explanations. This furthermore builds upon turn taking and understanding of others interests and opinions.

If you have not seen your child's workbook yet, then do ask one of the staff members to show you.

The children have also been taught about safety this month and have focused a lot on car safety, safety at home and how to stay safe on the roads.

## **Parent/Carer Questionnaire**

Many thanks to everyone who took the time to complete one of our questionnaires. This year we had 19 responses and are pleased to report that 87% of all replies rated us as very good or excellent, across the 10 areas covered in the questionnaire. #### Fee Increase

Our annual fee increase will come into effect on the first of September.

As usual we have made every effort to keep the fee increase to a minimum, but we are faced every year with increases in the national minimum wage. From the 1st of September a half-day session will now cost £29.00, a full day will cost £50.00 and a full week will be £220.00.

#### **Funded hours**

From the start of the new school year in September we are introducing a new, easy to understand cost structure covering meals and our wrap-around service where used. The times of the funded session aren't changing and the overall costs will be similar to what you would be or are currently paying.

The new structure is detailed in the attached document. In summary, meals are charged for as provided and the wrap-around service costs £5.80 per hour (the same hourly rate as our standard half-day session). If you have any queries on this then please let Helen or David know and they will be pleased to answer them.

#### **Harvest Festival**

Over the next month we will be collecting for our Harvest Festival hamper. We will be celebrating the Harvest Festival around the first week in September. A collection box will be placed in the entrance lobby for all food donations (tinned or packet only please – not fresh).

Last year we donated everything we collected to Calderdale SmartMove, a local charity helping homeless, where it was very gratefully received. However, should any parents/carers have a particular charity or cause which they feel would benefit from our collection please let us know and we will take all suggestions into consideration when making our final decision.

#### **Staff Member of the Month**

Although we had a few votes this month for our "Staff Member of the Month" award, there is no outright winner so all votes will be rolled over towards next month's award.

A huge thank you to all parents/ carers who take the time to vote. It means a lot to staff to know that their efforts are appreciated.
