### 30 Hours funded childcare starting in September 2017

Finally, after several meetings and lengthy discussions with Early Years, we are happy to announce that we will be offering the 30 hours funded childcare from September 2017.

The model we are using is the stretched model where instead of being paid term time only, the funding will be for 22 hours per week stretched over 51 weeks. Parents who wish to only access the current 15 hours offer will be able to continue to do so. There is no obligation to take up the full 30 hours.

If you are thinking about taking up the offer of the 30 hours it is really important that firstly you log on to the government childcare choices website <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> to check if you are eligible. If you are eligible please bring your eligibility code and national insurance number to Helen as soon as possible. If you would like to increase your child's sessions please make arrangements to discuss our availability with Helen straight away as we will be allocating the extra 15 hours strictly on a first come first served basis.

This note is just to inform parent/ carers that we will be offering the funding. A full explanation of how the funding is broken down and what it does and does not cover will follow in the next couple of weeks.

In the meantime if parent/ carers have any questions or concerns please speak to Helen and she will be delighted to answer and queries you may have.
